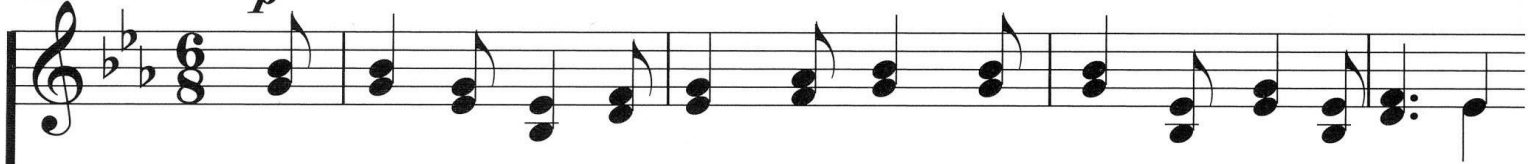

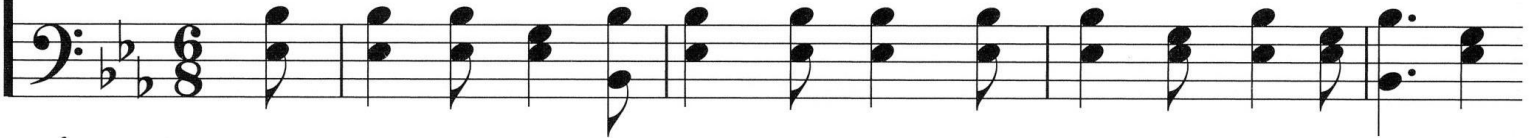

- (7.) And when to that bright world a - bove, We rise to see our Je - sus,





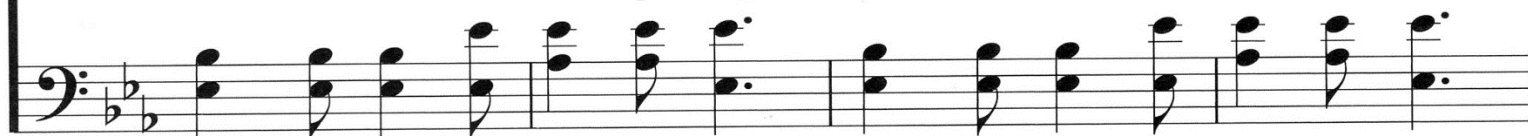
- (1.) But from the roof they let him down, Be - fore the face of Je - sus.
