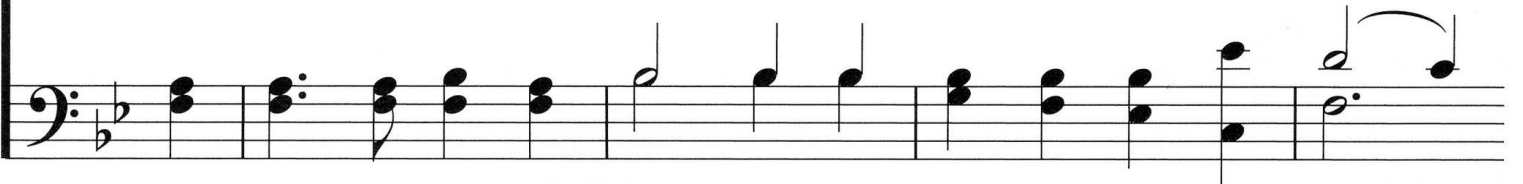
1. Stand up! – stand up for Je - sus! Ye sol - diers of the cross;

6. Stand up! – stand up for Je - sus! The strife will not be long;

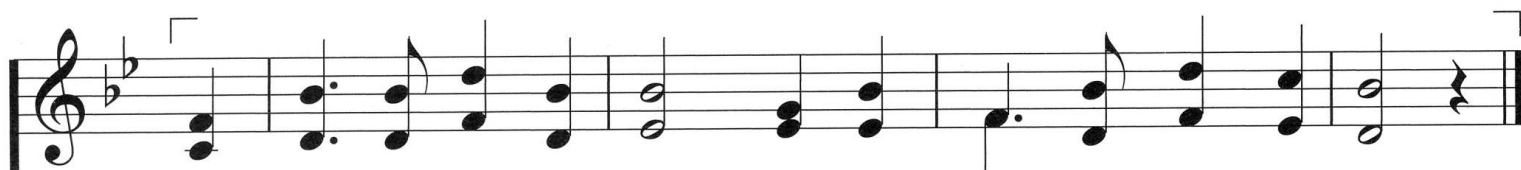


- (1.) Lift high his roy - al ban - ner, It must not suf - fer loss.
